Project Information

Skanska has been chosen to provide CM/GC services for the North Clackamas School District's Milwaukie High School. The Project consists of replacing the main building, renovating support buildings, and improving parking lots and fields. The main building and health and wellness center will be demolished to make way for a new 130,000 SF academic building featuring an open-air lobby and media center. The Commons building will see an upgraded dining area and health and wellness center, and the Performing Arts Center and Gymnasium will have changes as well. On-site and nearby fields will be enhanced and parking options will increase. During all this work, school will remain in session, and the students will attend class in temporary modular classrooms on the existing football field.

Upcoming Work

Beginning at the end of March, modular trailers will be delivered to the school for use in the "MOD City" temporary classrooms. These classrooms, which will be organized on the existing football field, will serve as the temporary home of MHS students during the 2018-19 and 2019-20 school years while construction is underway.

What to Expect

Mobilization is about to begin. Local residents can expect the modular trailers to be delivered between the end of March and the end of May between the hours of 9 am and 2 pm on a designated haul route. There should be no more than 6 trailers delivered in any given day. Those trailers will continue to be connected, furnished, and cleaned throughout the summer in preparation for the school year.
